

MINUTES OF THE 06/30/2008 CALLED MEETING


City Council met in a Called Session on June 30, 2008 with Mayor Edward E. Towns presiding and the following Aldermen were present: Eric Bisher, Gary Ates, David Sawyer, and Charles Cranford. Absent were Aldermen Leo Mullis and Willie Basby.

A public hearing on the proposed budget for FY 2008-2009 was held at 7:00 p.m., June 30, 2008 in the Council Chambers of Cochran City Hall with no citizens in attendance. Due to the fact that there were no objections or public opinions regarding the proposed budget, a motion was made by Alderman Bisher seconded by Alderman Ates to adopt the budget for fiscal year 2008-2009. The total expenditures for the FY 2008-2009 budget are \$6,858,900.00. Motion carried.

A resolution was introduced by Alderman Bisher seconded by Alderman Ates to enter into an agreement with the Georgia Department of Transportation to sponsor the City of Cochran's FY08 General Aviation Entitlement Grant from the Federal Aviation Administration in the amount of \$111,240.00. These funds are to be accepted by the City of Cochran for the design work for the construction of the apron and terminal area for the Cochran Municipal Airport. Upon polling Council and the vote being unanimous, Mayor Towns declared said resolution adopted.

Motion by Alderman Bisher seconded by Alderman Ates to adjourn meeting. Motion carried.
