 - 1. Confirmed receipt of a \$314,000 USDA grant for fire station renovations, along with updates on fire safety education tools and initiatives.
 - 2. Heard Public Works updates on water system issues, recent repairs, and ongoing maintenance and infrastructure needs.
 - 3. Reviewed major engineering and capital projects, including park improvements, drainage work, and long-term water and sewer planning.
 - 4. Considered and rejected the GDOT/Atlas multi-use path proposal due to cost, directing focus toward more practical local alternatives.
 - 5. Discussed solid waste service bids, emphasizing customer service quality and reliability.
 - 6. Reviewed a proposal to restructure building inspections to retain permit revenue and reduce liability exposure.
 - 7. Received detailed budget and audit updates, including the need for a FY 2024–25 budget amendment.
 - 8. Discussed AMI metering, with council directing staff to prioritize water meters over gas meters.
 - 9. Reviewed upcoming grant opportunities (CHIP and CDBG) and next steps.

- 10. Discussed council retreat planning and technology needs for elected officials.
 11. Approved a parade route request.
 12. Concluded with recognition of staff efforts during short staffing, holiday well-wishes, and adjournment.
