Background and Summary

The Georgia Department of Transportation has tentatively awarded Fiscal Year 2027 funding for the above-mentioned project at the airport. The project requires \$1,900 in matching funds from the City of Cochran.

Background and Summary

This is an agreement between the FAA and the City of Cochran, regarding maintenance of the AWOS (Automated Weather Observation System) that is on airport premises. The agreement is required the FAA to perform an inspection of the AWOS.

Background and Summary
